**Re: Member Motion M-1; October 29, 2019 City Council Meeting
CKLU – Downtown Sudbury Community Radio Marketing Program**

We are proud Laurentian University Alumni who greatly appreciate the value that CKLU brings to Laurentian University and northeastern Ontario through its music, political, health, and sports programming.

Recognizing funding changes that may pose a challenge to CKLU's continued delivery of radio programming, we are writing to advise that we are prepared to make a one-time monetary donation of \$25,000 to CKLU to ensure that the station may continue to offer its excellent programming across northeastern Ontario.

Our donation is conditional on the resolution of a minor property boundary issue affecting the University and our home at 2115 South Bay Road (details available at: www.laurentian.org), with counsel for ourselves and the University finalizing the matter in accordance with communications they have already exchanged. Since November 2017, the Laurentian University Board of Governors has spent more than \$66,000 on external legal services rendered in this matter. The Board continues to spend its limited resources litigating this issue despite our willingness to resolve this conflict with the University in a manner that we think is very reasonable.

Enclosed is a copy of a similar donation proposal that was presented at the July 2019 meeting of the CKLU Board of Directors, which the Board voted against.

We welcome City Council and CKLU to contact us before November 15, 2019 to discuss our possible donation towards supporting campus radio.

We look forward to supporting the City of Greater Sudbury, CKLU, as well as other Laurentian University initiatives in the future.

Re: Decision of FIPPA Request 2019-010 (our file number)

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with a decision further to your access to information request made pursuant to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* ("FIPPA" or "the Act") of Ontario.

Your request, which was officially received by Laurentian University of Sudbury ("the University") on June 3, 2019, was for access to the following records:

- a. Requesting the total dollar value that Laurentian University paid (or to be paid) to Fasken Martineau DuMoulin LLP for legal services rendered between the period of November 23, 2017 and May 28, 2019 (excluding itemized invoices that may disclose privileged information).
- b. Requesting the total dollar value that Laurentian University paid (or to be paid) to Fasken Martineau DuMoulin LLP for legal services rendered by Ms. Sarah J. Turney in the matter of 2115 South Bay Road, Sudbury, Ontario (the "Crispo/Ansell Property") (excluding itemized invoices that may disclose privileged information).
- c. Requesting the total dollar value that Laurentian University paid (or to be paid) for all external legal services rendered in the matter of 2115 South Bay Road, Sudbury, Ontario (the "Crispo/Ansell Property") (excluding itemized invoices that may disclose privileged information).


- d. In the alternative to (a), (b), and (c), requesting copies of all invoices, statements, or payment records related to payment(s) made by Laurentian University (or to be paid) for any external legal services rendered in the matter of 2115 South Bay Road, Sudbury, Ontario (the "Crispo/Ansell Property").

Pursuant to the provisions of FIPPA, the University has reviewed your above-noted request and is granting access to the information you requested. The total amount payable to Fasken Martineau DuMoulin LLP for legal services rendered between the period of November 23, 2017 and May 28, 2019 is \$63,927.41. The total amount payable to Fasken Martineau DuMoulin LLP for legal services rendered by Ms. Turney (or under her supervision) in the matter of 2115 South Bay Road, Sudbury, Ontario is also \$63,927.41. The total amount payable for external legal services rendered in the matter of 2115 South Bay Road Sudbury Ontario is \$66,427.41.

Having granted access to the above requested information, our office will proceed with closing your file.
